## Introduction

Welcome to the UnRisk Excel Add-In Installation Guide. This guide will take you through setup, license activation, and initial steps to start using UnRisk Excel.

## System Requirements

Ensure your system meets the following requirements before installing the UnRisk Excel Add-In:

- **Operating System:** Microsoft Windows
- **Microsoft Excel:** Version 2208 or higher

## Installing the UnRisk Excel Add-In

### Step 1: Downloading the Installation File

- Please use the link provided in your **“Welcome to UnRisk email”** to download UnRisk Excel. Use the **download password** from the email.
- Note: The link is valid for a maximum of 30 days.
- If you did not receive a welcome email, please contact support at [support@unrisk.com](mailto:support@unrisk.com).

## Step 2: Installing the UnRisk Excel Add-In

- Please **save and close** all currently opened **Excel** Workbooks
- **Open** the downloaded **Installation File** and choose a language and follow the installation steps.
- (This step only applies if you already have an older version of UnRisk Excel installed)  
A message will appear indicating that the old certificate is being removed. Click **“Yes”** to continue.

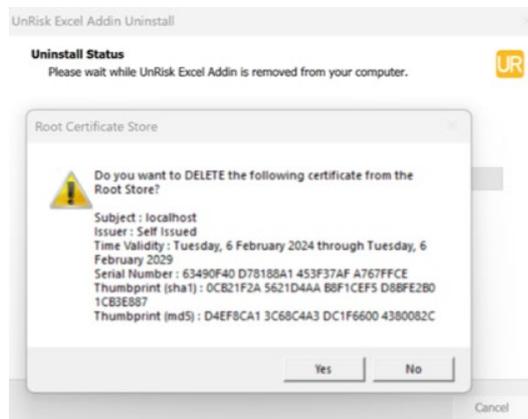


Figure 1: Warning that the old certificate is being removed during update of the Add-In

- In the next step, a **security warning\*** that a localhost certificate will be installed appears. Please click **“Yes”** to proceed.

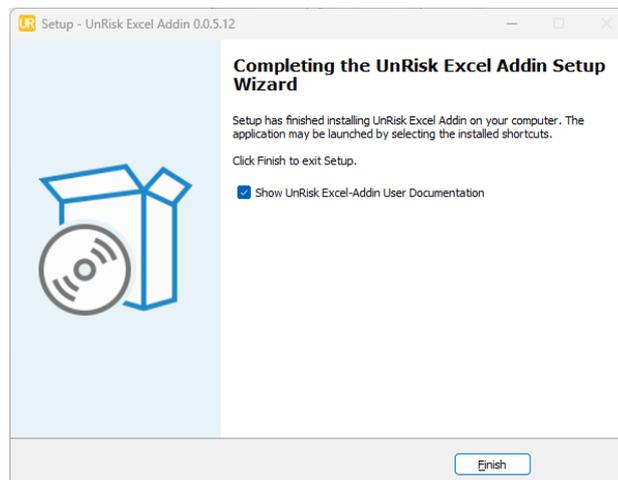
## **\*Notice: Security Warning During UnRisk Excel Add-In Installation**

A key feature of the UnRisk Excel Add-In is its ability to function offline. Since modern Office 365 Add-Ins must be hosted on a web server, the offline use of the UnRisk Excel Add-In requires a locally running web server.

To ensure a secure HTTPS connection, the Add-In uses a self-signed certificate. Public certificates cannot be issued for local servers like localhost, so the installer adds this self-signed certificate to your computer as a trusted source. This is a standard procedure and is considered safe – it poses no threat to your data or system.

The Windows security warning that appears during installation simply notifies you that a self-signed certificate is in use. This warning is uncritical, as the certificate is used exclusively on your local machine and does not establish any connection to external servers.

- **Important:** All open Excel workbooks will be closed during installation. Save any open files to prevent data loss.
- **Before completing the final step**, please close your browser.
- In the final step, the **User Documentation** will automatically open in your browser if the checkbox is selected and you clicked on **“Finish”**.

- When you open Excel, the **UnRisk Excel Add-In** should now be visible in the toolbar  and the side pane.

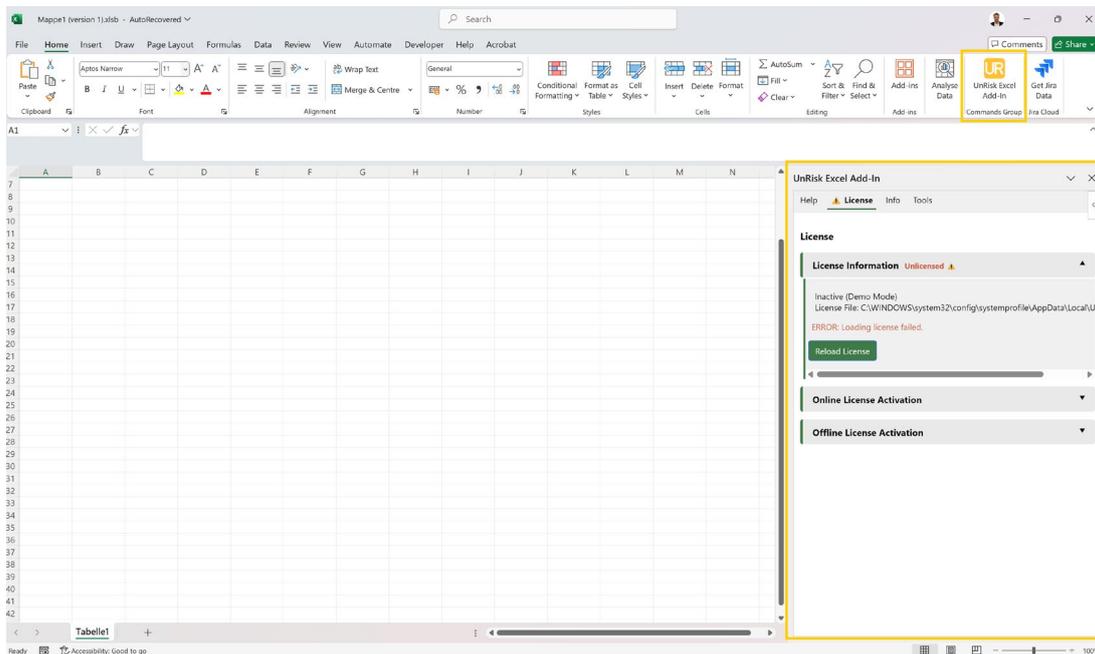


Figure 5: Excel interface after successful installation of the UnRisk Add-In, with the navigation pane displayed on the right side. If the side pane isn't open, click the Add-In icon in the toolbar to display it.

## Troubleshooting (UnRisk Add-In not visible in Ribbon)

- Navigate to Home → Add-Ins → More Add-ins → Shared Folder
- Select the UnRisk Excel Add-In and press the "Add" button

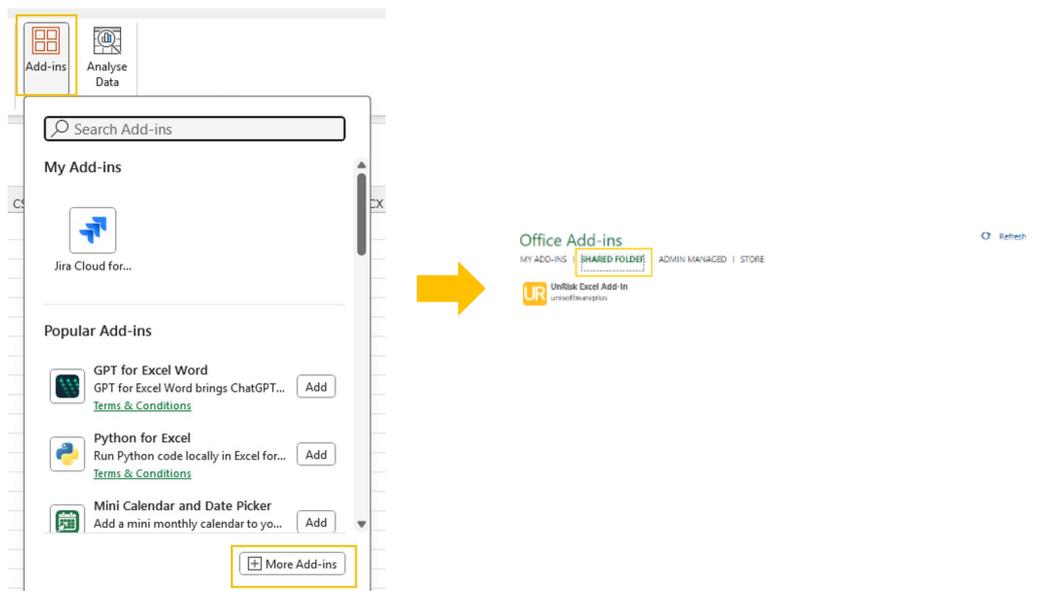


Figure 6: In rare cases, the UnRisk Excel Add-In does not appear in the ribbon after installation. If this happens, it can be added manually via Home → Add-Ins → More Add-ins → Shared Folder.

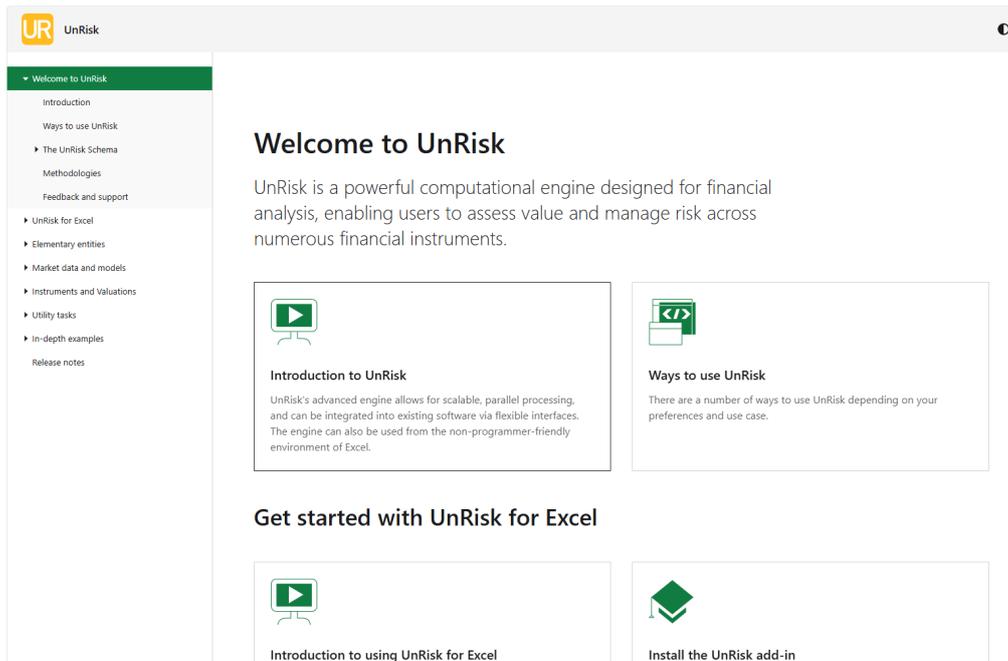


Figure 4 Landing page of the **UnRisk Excel** Documentation

## License Activation

If you already have an activated license, you can skip this section. To confirm activation, check the **License Information** tab in the UnRisk Excel side pane.

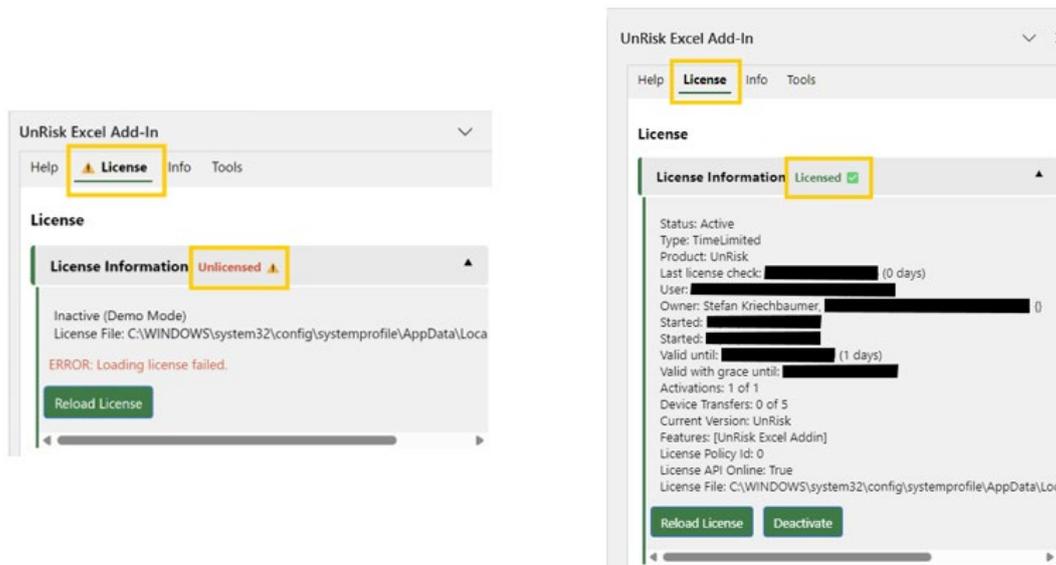


Figure 6: Left pane shows "Unlicensed" with an error; Right pane shows "Licensed" with activation details.

UnRisk Excel offers two methods for license activation. Choose either online activation or offline activation.

- **Online Activation (Standard)** – Requires an internet connection on your computer.
- **Offline Activation** – For computers without internet access to the UnRisk License Service.

### Option 1: Online License Activation

- Ensure your computer is connected to the internet.
- Enter the credentials provided by the UnRisk Support Team (e.g. Welcome email).
- Click "Activate Online." If successful, you can begin using UnRisk Excel.

## Option 2: Offline License Activation

For computers without internet access, follow these steps:

- Enter the email address you registered with (the address that received the “Welcome to UnRisk Excel” email).
- Click “Generate Activation Request.”

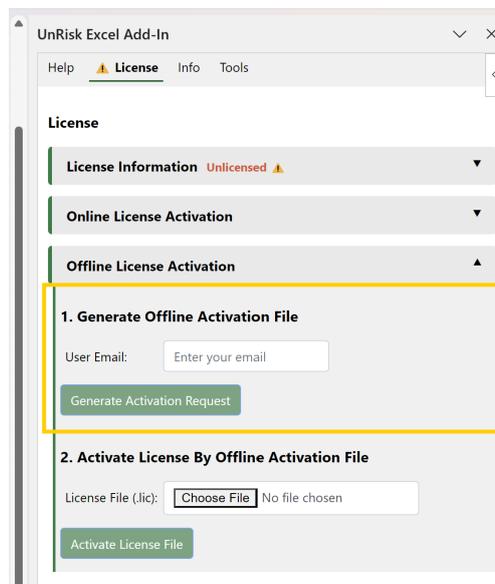


Figure 7: Step for generation of the activation file needed by the UnRisk Support to generate the License File

- Send the generated **OfflineActivationFile** to UnRisk support at [support@unrisk.com](mailto:support@unrisk.com).
- The support team will provide you with a License File.
- Select the provided file in the License File field and click “Activate License File.”

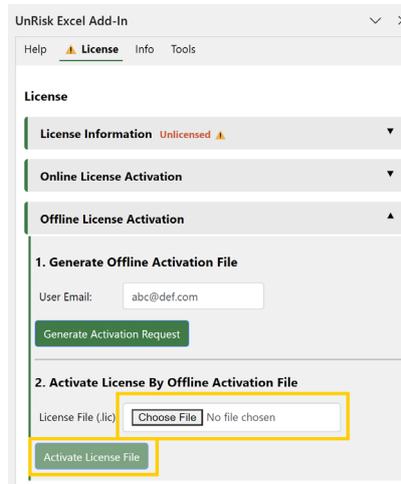


Figure 8: Step for offline license activation, selecting the license file to activate the UnRisk Excel Add-In.
